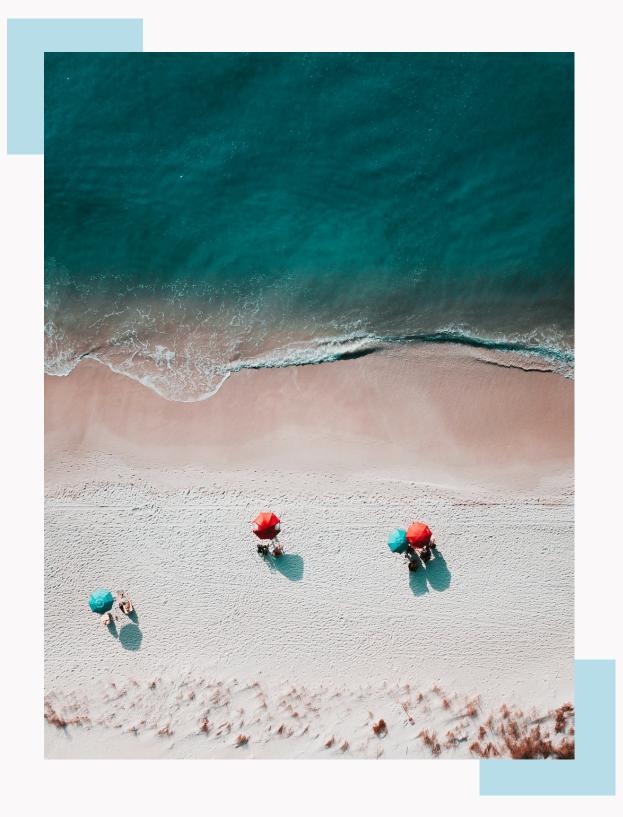


DOORS REOPEN

Survey conducted by Wayaj May 14-24, 2020





How this survey was conducted

As part of the Sustainable Hospitality in Progress initiative aimed at promoting best sustainable practices via sharing and networking, Wayaj conducted this survey among 59 industry professionals to outline the new practices they are putting in place to reopen their doors and bring guests back.

Less than 50 = 69.5%

Asia = 11.9%

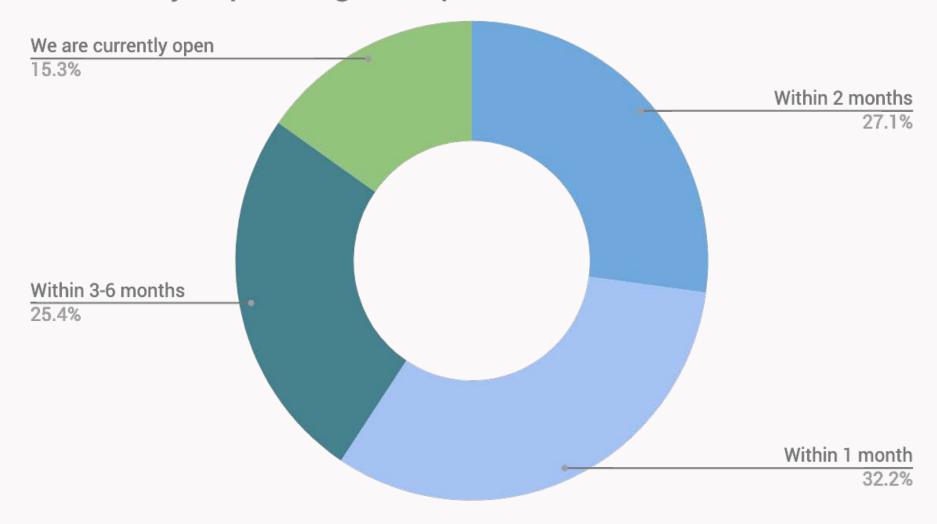

A New Clean

After the pandemic, cleaning and sanitization practices will be crucial to attract guests, which new measures will you be putting in place? (*multiple choice)

- Retraining housekeeping staff: 81.3%
- Enhanced sanitizing procedures (ozone cleaning etc..): 72.8%
- Employ stronger cleaning products 50.5%
- Obtain health certification: 49.1%
- New equipment (air filtration, contactless, keyless etc...): 42.3%
- Longer time between occupancies: 40.2%

18.6% of hotels will implement all the above

Taking temperature and checking health conditions of staff and incoming guests

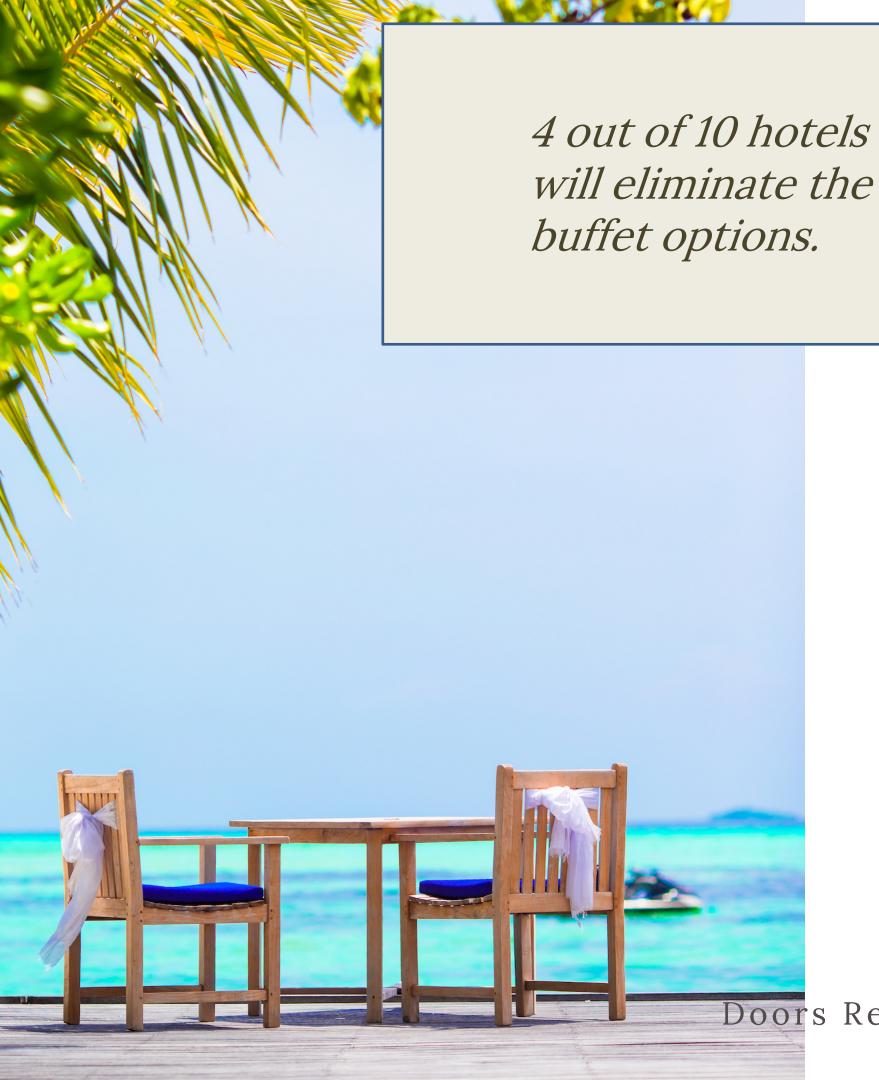
Staff only: 20%

Staff and Guests: 50%

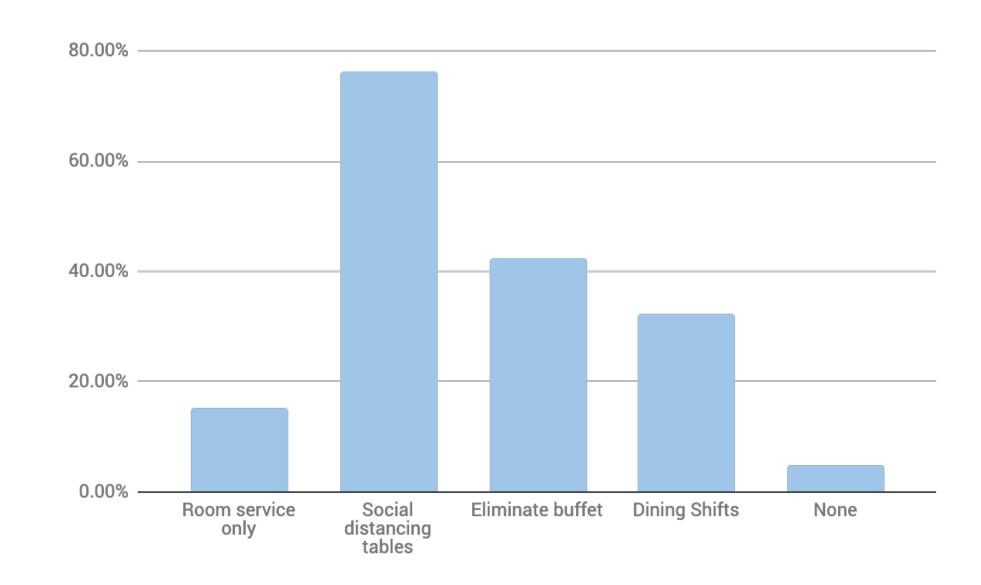
No personal health checks: 23.3%

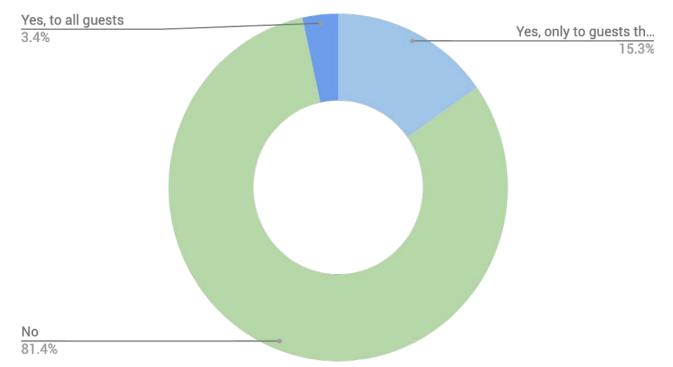

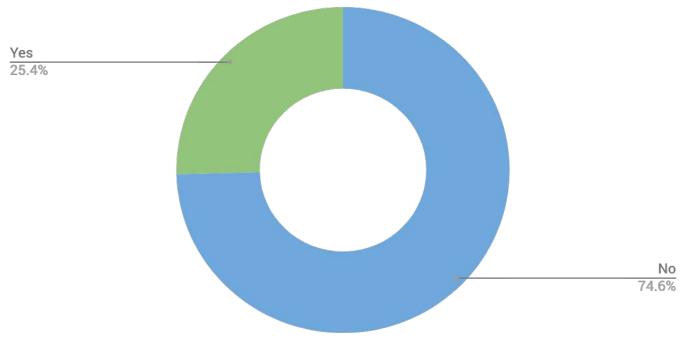
Are you planning to charge a new fee/tax for cleaning?



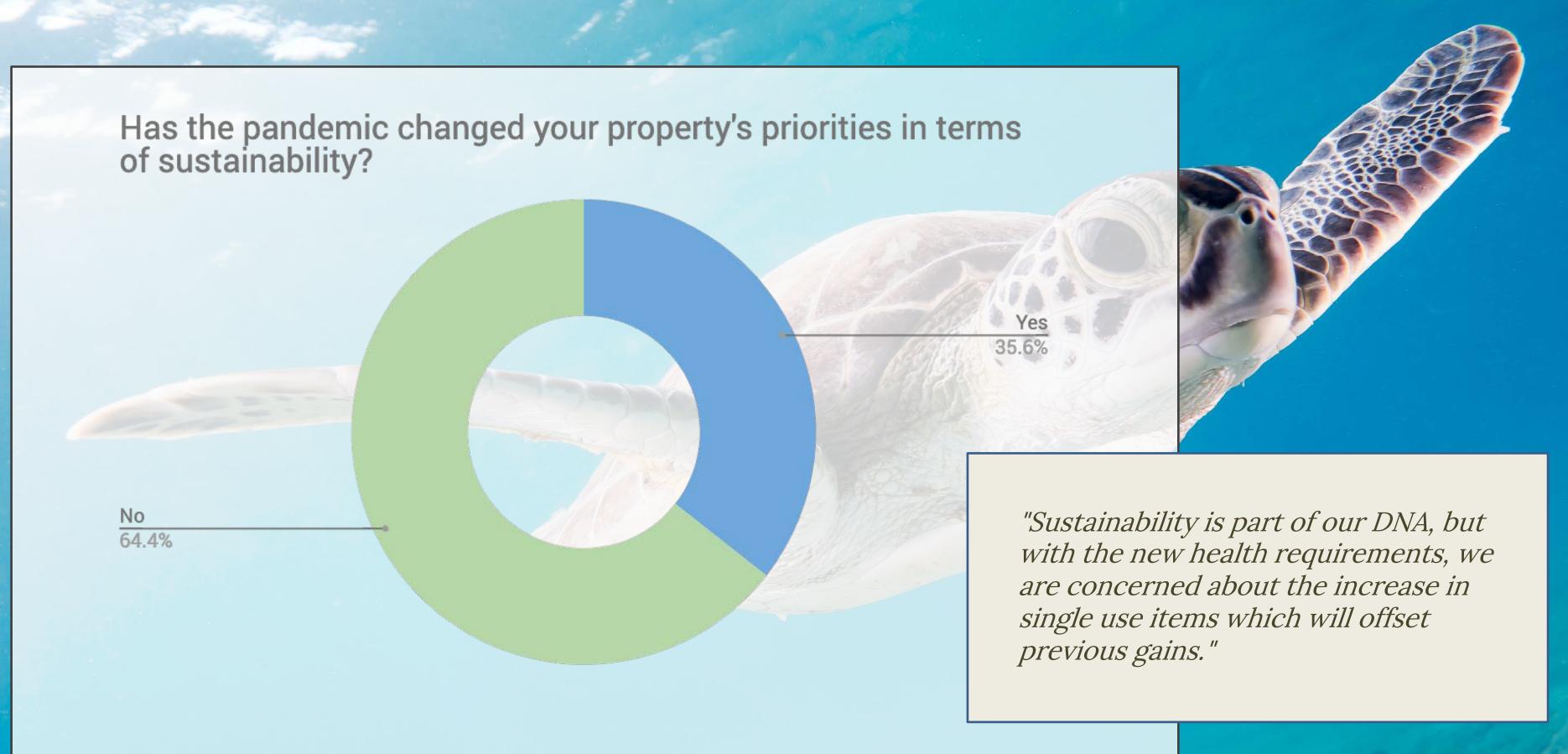

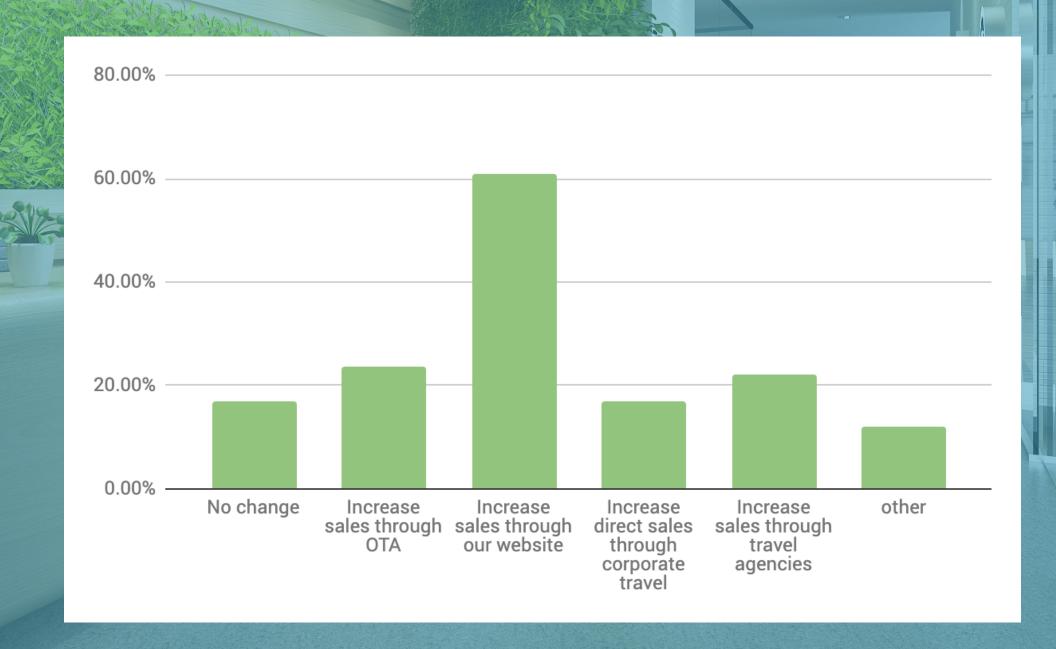


"We're adopting cost-effective flexible staffing according to occupancy, however, not at the detriment of the quality of service. Quality and hygiene are key for the reopening."



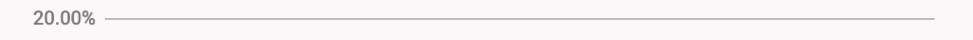

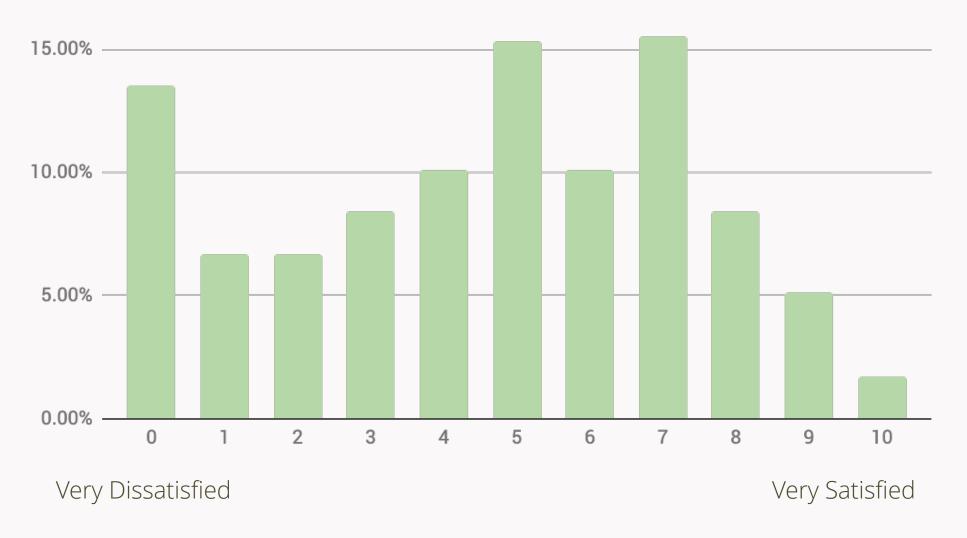
Has the pandemic changed your distribution strategy? (*multiple choice)
